- by meeting and (where possible) exceeding all relevant legislation and industry standards
- by demonstrating continuous improvement in our activities to monitor and control our impact on the environment.
- monitoring internal and external KPI's and SLA's as tools to meet our environmental commitments and targets, with findings to be reviewed and discussed as part of management review and continuous improvement
- instilling a culture of improving environmental performance through formal checking procedures, collation and reporting of findings and feedback
- by engaging and supporting the interaction of all staff with our environmental aims through communication of; this Policy, environmental KPIs, identified Aspects & Impacts and core Objectives, alongside a programme of training and awareness.


